DROICHEAD FAMILY RESOURCE CENTRE: FREE: Basic Computer Classes: DFRC is pleased to inform you that it has received additional places under the 'Getting Citizens Online Programme Initiative'. Droichead Family Resource Centre will be facilitating a number of **Free basic Computer** courses between January and June 2018. These ten hour part time courses are free to participants who meet specific criteria and will be commencing shortly in Droichead Family Resource Centre. Courses will be running both in the mornings and the evenings and of two hour duration. The courses will include the following topics: Introduction to the Internet, Internet Safety & security, Email, Search Engines and websites, Online Government Services, Conduction everyday transactions, Online voice and video calls, Use of 'Apps', Other – lifestyle choices options i.e. online banking, shopping online etc. This project is assisted by funding from the Department of Communication, Climate Action & Environment.
