HEART SCREENING: Pulsewave Ireland Heart & Artery screening in Kilkenny next week. The Bpro certified to measure CASP to 99.17% in comparison to an angiogram and as seen on TV. As Heart Disease is still the biggest killer in Ireland we try to make it affordable for everyone to be screened. Normal cost of screening is €50 per person, Parish offer €30 per person for that we check your Blood Pressure, Heart Rhythm, Casp of heart, arterial flexibility and Blood flow. We can access the risk of heart attack or stroke with a simple non-invasive test. Venues as follows: Thursday 16th August The Talbot Hotel Carlow & Friday 17th August Hotel Kilkenny.
